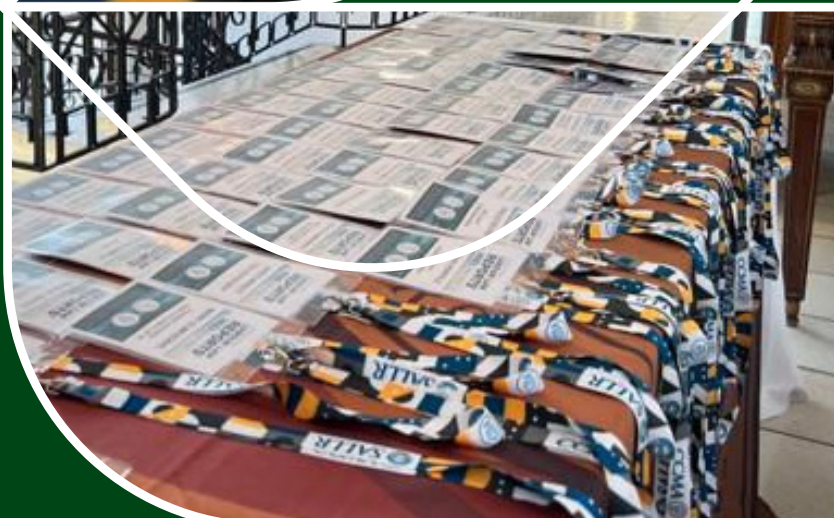

Adv Morajane is an accomplished and seasoned executive leader with extensive experience in corporate law, labour law, dispute resolution, dispute management and prevention, public service and organisational management. Before joining the CCMA, he was in private practice for 10 years and later joined the National Education, Health and

Allied Workers Union ('NEHAWU') as the national legal co-ordinator. Adv Morajane is a Thought Leader and a sought-after speaker, both locally and internationally, in labour law matters. At the CCMA, he oversees all disputes that are strategic and of precedent setting nature. He is the recipient of the Leadership Award from the Law Society of South Africa. He holds the degrees BJuris, LLB and LLM as well as various diplomas. He is currently pursuing his doctorate of law degree (LLD) at UJ.
